Summary of proceedings of the 40th Annual General Meeting

The 40th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Members of THERMAX LIMITED ('the Company') was held on Friday, August 6, 2021 at 4.00 p.m. (IST) through Video Conferencing (VC).
